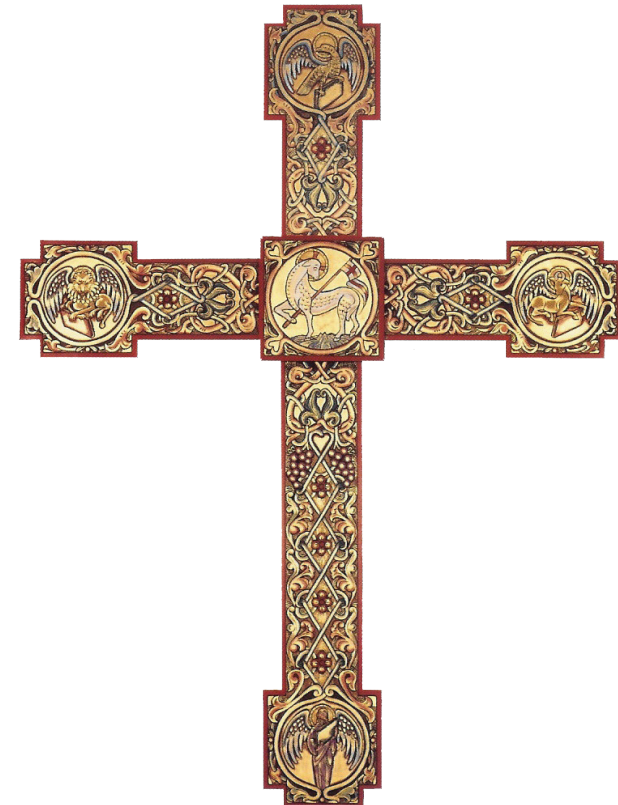

To commemorate All Saints Sunday, the Chancel Choir is singing the Duruflé Requiem conducted by Dr. Todd Prickett. Composed by Maurice Duruflé (1902-1986), the inspired use of Gregorian chant forms the foundation and spiritual center for the piece. Listeners describe plainchant as “the song of the soul” and “an expression of true prayer.” Duruflé’s use of dramatic dynamic changes and contemporary harmonies add to the grandeur and beauty of the work.

Red text is read by the congregation. Asterisks (\*) indicate times when you are invited to stand. Feel free to remain seated if need be.
