

Map of University Christian Church




Words from our Senior Minister

Many of you have mentioned to me that there is a renewed sense of excitement and enthusiasm in our congregation. I feel it too. It's almost palpable. In the days ahead, our aim will be to continue to build off that momentum and energy, to continue to move towards being even more like the church that God created and calls us to be.

For the last several months, the church leadership has been looking at our ministry staff alignment and responsibilities to ensure we have the right people in the right places, utilizing the gifts of our remarkable and incredibly talented clergy staff. We've also been talking a great deal about how we can better serve the congregation by working more collaboratively as a ministry team.

An important piece to that puzzle was bringing in a dynamic person with strong administrative skills to help manage the ministry of the congregation as an Executive Minister. We have found that person and are thrilled to welcome Rev. Renee Hoke to our staff, beginning June 10. Renee is a native Texan with vast experience in both the corporate world and in the church. Following a successful career as a television news reporter and anchor, and later in corporate communications.

She left that world to attend Brite Divinity School and prepare for ministry. Since then, she has served with both local congregations and the Area church, specializing in working with congregations in transition. I know that Renee with her wonderful gifts, creativity and experience will be an incredible asset to our ministry team!

As we prepare to welcome an Executive Minister that will continue to help shape our ministry team, we'll also be making some shifts in responsibilities amongst our other ministers as well. These shifts will take place over the next few months as we live into this new way of serving and leading the congregation.

Going forward, Rev. Cyndy Twedell will take the lead on Pastoral Care and Women's and Men's Ministries; Rev. Shannon Moore will be the point person for Adult Education, New Member Integration and Worship; Rev. Jessica Vacketta will continue to work with College and Young Adult Ministries, overseeing the Growing Young initiative as well as Outreach.


Along with these new responsibilities, we're also changing the titles of some of our ministers to be more reflective of UCC's evolving ministries. Recently, the Personnel Committee and Board of Stewards unanimously approved doing away with the "Associate Minister" title. That title conveys a feeling of hierarchy that we'd like to get away from in our collaborative approach to doing ministry. Instead, we'll use "Minister of..." designations. In the coming weeks, Rev. Cyndy Twedell will become Minister of Nurture; Rev. Shannon Moore will soon be our Minister of Faith Formation; Rev. Jessica Vacketta will carry the title of Minister of Connections. While their job portfolios will not change, Rev. Kera Watts will be known as Minister of Children and Families; Jamie Plunkett will carry the title of Minister of Youth and Families; and Rev. Dr. Todd Prickett will continue to be serve as Minister of Music. While this may sound like a small change, it has tremendous implications about how we envision and empower our ministry staff.

I recognize that transitions can sometimes be difficult and scary. And UCC has certainly had a great deal of transition in the last several months. But these shifts can also be life-giving and exciting as we move toward the future that God envisions for us. I am so proud of the way our staff is working together to create a cohesive, collaborative team that serves the congregation in exciting ways. We have such a gifted and talented staff that truly believes in providing a ministry of excellence that UCC has long expected and enjoyed.

I for one, am incredibly excited about the direction in which we are headed and feel so blessed to be a part of such an amazing team that serves and leads this vital, thriving congregation. I give thanks each day for the opportunity to serve God alongside each of you at University Christian Church!
