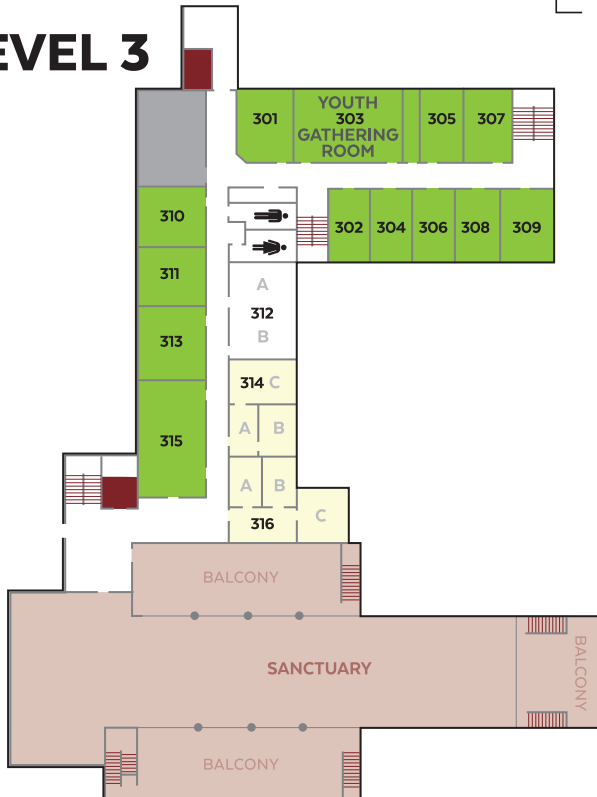

Words from our Senior Minister

Where are we? Where are we going?

How are we going to get there?

This is an exciting time to be a part of University Christian Church. During the past year, this congregation has experienced enthusiasm, growth, and a renewed energy. I feel it, and I hope you do to.

Therefore, it is important for us, at this time in our history, to take important steps to build upon that momentum. This is the perfect time for us to carefully and prayerfully discern God's vision for our church, in this next season in our life together.

I believe strongly that we need to undertake a strategic discernment process to establish a foundation for us to move forward in the next 5-10 years of our life together. This process will address three primary questions: Where are we? Where are we going? How are we going to get there?

To help us answer these questions, the Board of Stewards has approved the hiring of a consultant, Mike Bonem, (www.mikebonem.com) to help lead us in this process. Mike comes highly regarded with an incredible track record of helping congregations create a clear, shared, and compelling vision that provides direction for the future.

This process will take about a year. The first phase will include Mike helping us to define our current reality. You can't get to where you are going without knowing where you are. We'll think carefully about our heritage, culture, and strengths and begin to consider how that shapes where God is calling us to go. That process is already underway. We'll be building on the work of the task force, that has been underway for the last several months—articulating a new vision, mission and core values that undergird our life together.

Phase two will be the heart of this project, as we finalize our vision and develop a plan to live into that vision. This phase will take about six months as we design the visionpath that will best enable the church to move toward this understanding of God's call for us. A strategic vision team will work to identify and articulate a few strategic priorities, each with their own plans and goals. This may include such things as adding a new worship service that involves a different style of worship; a new outreach initiative that builds on the incredible work we are

already doing to transform the community; a new small group ministry that helps us build community and grow in our faith; and perhaps doing some improvements to

our campus that will allow our facility to reflect the welcoming, inclusive spirit of our congregation. At the end of this phase, we'll have a clear vision and path forward.

But of course, execution is key, and it is where most churches fail once a plan is adopted. Mike will be available to help us as we move into phase three, to insure we are successful in our implementation efforts. Working groups will be formed. They will focus on each strategic priority, begin work and bring them to fruition.

This is a diverse congregation. Diversity is part of what makes this church vital, unique and gives us depth. It also means where two are gathered, there are three (or more) opinions. Therefore, it will be important for us to gain clarity with respect to where we are, where we are going, and how we are going to get there.

I am excited about this next season. I truly believe that God is inviting us into an incredible, vital future. For now, I invite you to be in prayer for our beloved church as we prayerfully listen and discern where God is calling us to go and be.
